



Technology: Adoption S-Curve














Bitcoin vs Internet Adoption



Number of identity-verified cryptoasset users from 2016 to June 2023 (in millions)






Bitcoin is the Fastest Asset to Reach a \$1 Trillion Market Cap



Years to reach \$1 Trillion market cap




